CERTIFIED BUILDER AGREEMENT

1. A certified Builder member who undertakes proposed residential construction shall, prior to commencement of such construction, provide each customer with a contract that shall be fair and equitable in all respects to both parties.
2. A Certified Builder member (on new construction) shall issue to each customer or homeowner a one-year limited warranty commencing with the date of occupancy of the owner or the date of closing, whichever first occurs. This one-year limited warranty shall include at a minimum the provisions set forth in the Home Builders Association of Middle Tennessee "Home Owners Limited Warranty". Also, a member shall provide to each owner a copy of the booklet entitled Your New Home and How To Take Care of It.
3. Should a complaint be made to the Association against me for non-compliance with the foregoing requirements, or where any controversy with a customer exists, the complaint shall be assigned to the Certified Builder Committee for processing in accordance with the Dispute/Resolution/Mediation/Arbitration Procedures of the Certified Builder Program.
4. A Certified Builder member shall, where practical, present his business firm and himself to the public as a Certified Builder using the insignia when advertising to identify himself as such, and will use such promotional material as is made available within the Certified Builder Program.
7. Any member who disaffiliates his membership with the Home Builder Association of Middle Tennessee for any reason, voluntarily or involuntarily, automatically relinquishes his rights to the Certified Builder Program, its insignias, trademarks and privileges.
8. All new Certified Builders must obtain nine (9) credits of appropriate professional education within two (2) years of becoming a Certified Builder. These credits may be obtained in several ways:
 - (a) Complete all required courses of the Graduate Builder Institute (GBI), or its equivalent, as outlined by the local HBA. - 9 credits total
 - (b) Attend one (1) course of the GBI - 2 credits each
 - (c) Attend one or more half day business seminars sponsored by HBA or its local Sales and Marketing Council (SMC). - 2 credits each
 - (d) Attend the NAHB Convention. - 2 credits
 - (e) Attend one or more of the local HBA sponsored "Business Management Series" programs. - 1/2 credits each, up to 2 1/2 credits per year
 - (f) Attend one or more of the HBA monthly (5 per year) General Membership Meetings. - 1/2 credit each, up to 2 1/2 credits per year
 - (g) Certain full- or half-day seminars sponsored by the HBA, SMC, NAHB or Home Builders Institute (HBI), or local college level courses may also qualify for Certified Builder professional education credit. The Certified Builder Committee will determine how much credit will be given on an individual basis.

Once the minimum requirement of 9 credits in 2 years is met, any future continuing education will not be mandated and will be strictly voluntary for each builder member. The Certified Builder Committee may waive this requirement in the event a new member has equivalent educational training. In consideration of the promises of the applicant to comply with the conditions and requirements set forth above, the Home Builders Association of Middle Tennessee shall issue a certificate of qualification and shall assign a certificate number to the applicant Builder.
